# Edison Local Schools Launches Facilities Planning Initiative

Edison Local Schools has begun a comprehensive facilities planning process in partnership with GPD Group, a Cleveland-area architectural firm, and the Ohio Facilities Construction Commission (OFCC). This effort includes a thorough evaluation of existing school buildings and professional guidance on potential construction or renovation projects.

The planning process will assess the condition of each facility, explore options for improvement, and identify opportunities for state funding support through OFCC. The goal is to ensure decisions are informed, financially responsible and aligned with the long-term needs of the district.

GPD Group brings experience working with school districts across Ohio and is recognized for designing learning environments that support modern instructional practices. Their findings, along with input from OFCC, will help the district explore how facilities can best support student learning.

Edison Local Schools will continue to keep families and the community informed as the planning progresses.

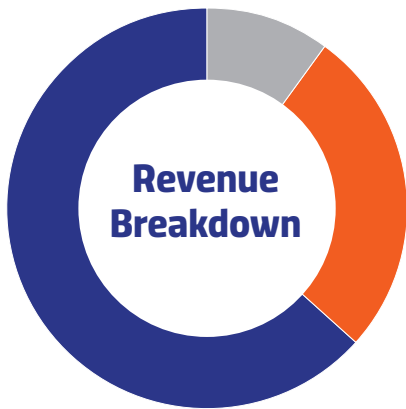

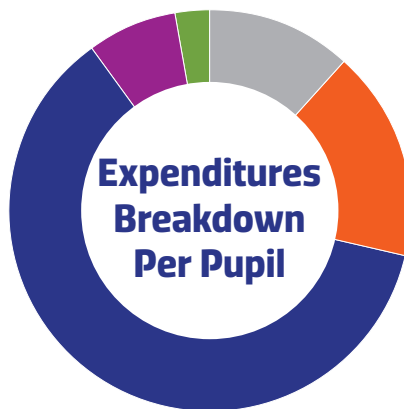

Each year, the Ohio Department of Education and Workforce evaluates districts on student achievement, graduation, progress, and readiness for the future. While the report card is only one measure of success, this year’s results show that Edison Local Schools are not just meeting expectations—we’re exceeding them.

Edison schools across all grade levels are showing impressive results. Our elementary and middle schools earned an average rating of 4.5 stars, reflecting the hard work of our students and the dedication of our teachers. At the high school, a solid 3.5-star rating highlights continued growth and momentum as we prepare students for success beyond graduation.

Statewide, income levels often align closely with report card results—but not here. In 2025, Edison ranked 134th of 607 districts on the Performance Index while our income rank was 329th. That’s a 195-place jump that puts Edison in the top 50 districts in Ohio—top 8 percent statewide—for exceeding expectations. Our students, staff, and community prove every day that opportunity and commitment—not income—drive success.

While we celebrate this progress, we remain focused on what’s ahead. Growth is a journey, and Edison Local Schools is committed to finding new ways to strengthen learning, foster career-connected experiences, and support every student’s success—from kindergarten through graduation and beyond.
